Following the recent release of the message announcing the U.S. Indo-Pacific Command co-sponsored Annual Pacific IO and EW Symposium 2020, I would like to draw your attention to the event and to extend an invitation to participate.

The symposium will take place at the Hale Koa Hotel, Armed Forces Recreation Center at Fort DeRussy, Honolulu. The program commences with a hosted social event in the hotel's Warrior Lounge on the evening of Monday, October 19. This is followed by two days of presentations and panels at the unclassified level on October 20 and 21. Admission to the symposium is gratis for U.S. and Allied active duty military personnel. On October 22 the event will move to Headquarters USINDOPACOM, Camp H. M. Smith for classified discussions. These will explore themes and issues identified during the event.

The Pacific IO/EW Symposium is USINDOPACOM's only professional development, international engagement and operational problem-solving event specifically focused on those Information Related Capabilities, Concepts and Activities that combine to deliver effective and Joint IO. The Symposium theme for this year is "IO and EW in All Domain operations from Competition to Conflict."

As well as presenting an excellent continuous professional development opportunity to learn more about IO and EW in the Region, this event also facilitates networking amongst a community of shared interest. If your representatives wish to present on a subject related to the theme, or participate in a panel, we would be delighted to consider adding them to the agenda.
